Eliseo D. Canete, Sr. was born on January 28th, 1943 in Lilo-an, Cebu, Philippines to Victoriano Pobe Canete & Esmeralda Cabugason Dolloso, both deceased. He was the beloved brother of Dr. Andrea Canete-Lumapas of Cebu, Philippines; Simplicio Pacana & Julieta Padilla, both deceased. He studied at the University of Santo Tomas & Cebu Institute of Technology & earned a Bachelor's Degree in Chemical Engineering. He worked as a Chemical Engineer at Atlas Consolidated Mining & Development Corporation, one of the Philippines' largest copper mine & had several business ventures. He married Lydia De Los Reyes in 1966 & had 5 children. He immigrated to the U.S. in 1995 & had taken on jobs in Customer Service & Environmental Service until his retirement in 2012.
