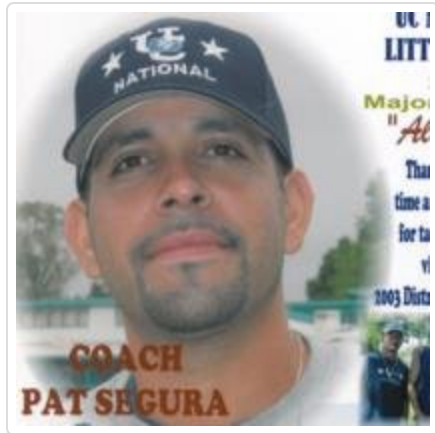




John Patrick Segura
