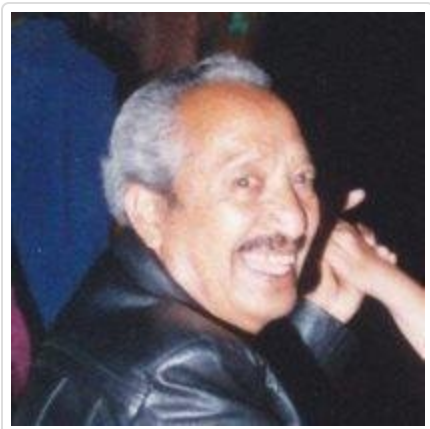




Pedro "Lupe" Granados
