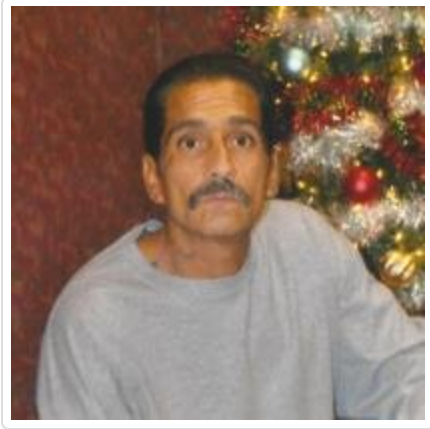




Robert "Poni Boy" Lee Mares, Jr.
